## High School Lecture Series

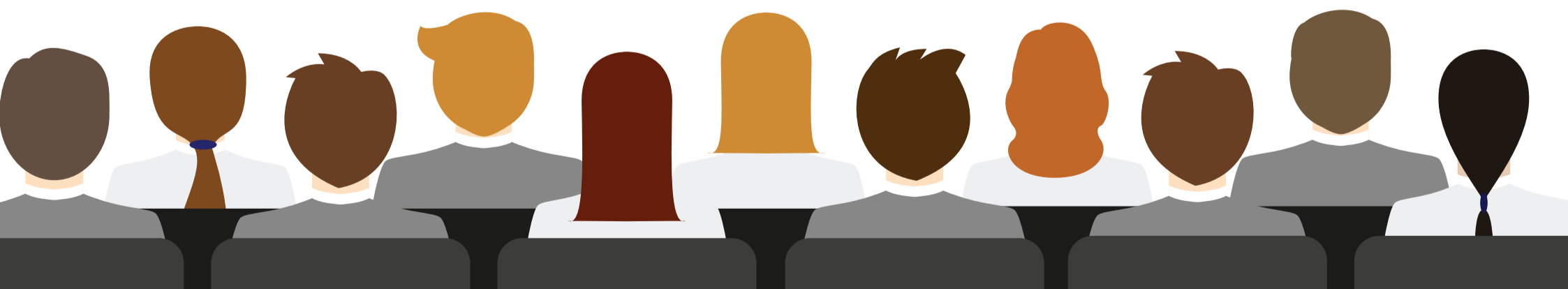
