

## Guidelines for abstract submission

Your abstract should be submitted as a Word Document or PDF with **minimum 2cm margins** and font set to **Arial, size 11**.

Your submission must be a brief **Scientific Abstract** of no more than 300 words (not including headings, authors and author's affiliations), explaining the research and its significance. The abstract must be plain text only, **no figures**.

### ► Abstract content must adhere to the following format:

**Title:** in **Sentence case, bold, left alignment**

**Authors:** include First name and Surname of all authors, separated by a comma, and **underline and bold** the presenting author. Each authors name should be followed by a superscript number to identify their affiliation.

**Authors' affiliations:** List the authors' affiliations, one on each line, with an identifying number in front followed by a full stop (not as a numbered list).

**Body text:** Sentence case. Leave two lines between the author affiliations list and the abstract text.
