

What do we work on?

Meta-analysis

Advising, mentoring or collaborating on analysis

Any research project

- Low and Negligible Risk and Full ethics
- HREC number must be provided prior to sending data
- Advising, mentoring or collaborating
- Experimental, quasi-experimental and non-experimental study designs
 - e.g. Clinical trials, Cohort studies, Cross-sectional, Case-control, Crossover, Surveys, Laboratory experiments, Case series

Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Improvement (QI) projects

- Including Ethics exemptions
- Assistance with the development of the research protocol
- We only provide group training and resources for the analysis component

We do not provide services for:

- Qualitative data analysis
- Health Economics

Clients generally contact us when writing a research grant or protocol.

We provide a sound statistical framework for their research by helping with:

- Formulating the research question
- Study design and analysis plan
- Power and sample size calculation
- Writing research grants and protocols
- Development of data collection sheets and data dictionaries
- Data cleaning and preparation for analysis
- Use of different statistical software packages
- Analysis of data, advice or mentoring through the analysis
- Presentation and interpretation of data
- Preparation of and co-authorship on publications
- Addressing reviewers' comments
